## PATHWAY PILIPINAS



- TSU joined six universities to launch Pathway Pilipinas, a nonprofit alliance for refugee education.
- The signing took place on March 25, 2025, at De La Salle Philippines.
- TSU is the only state university among the founding members.
- The alliance supports Rohingya refugees and stateless persons through scholarships and resources.
- The initiative is backed by DOJ-RSPPU and UNHCR, which praised the alliance's bayanihan spirit.

- Taiwanese universities presented academic programs; Filipino students shared study-abroad experiences.



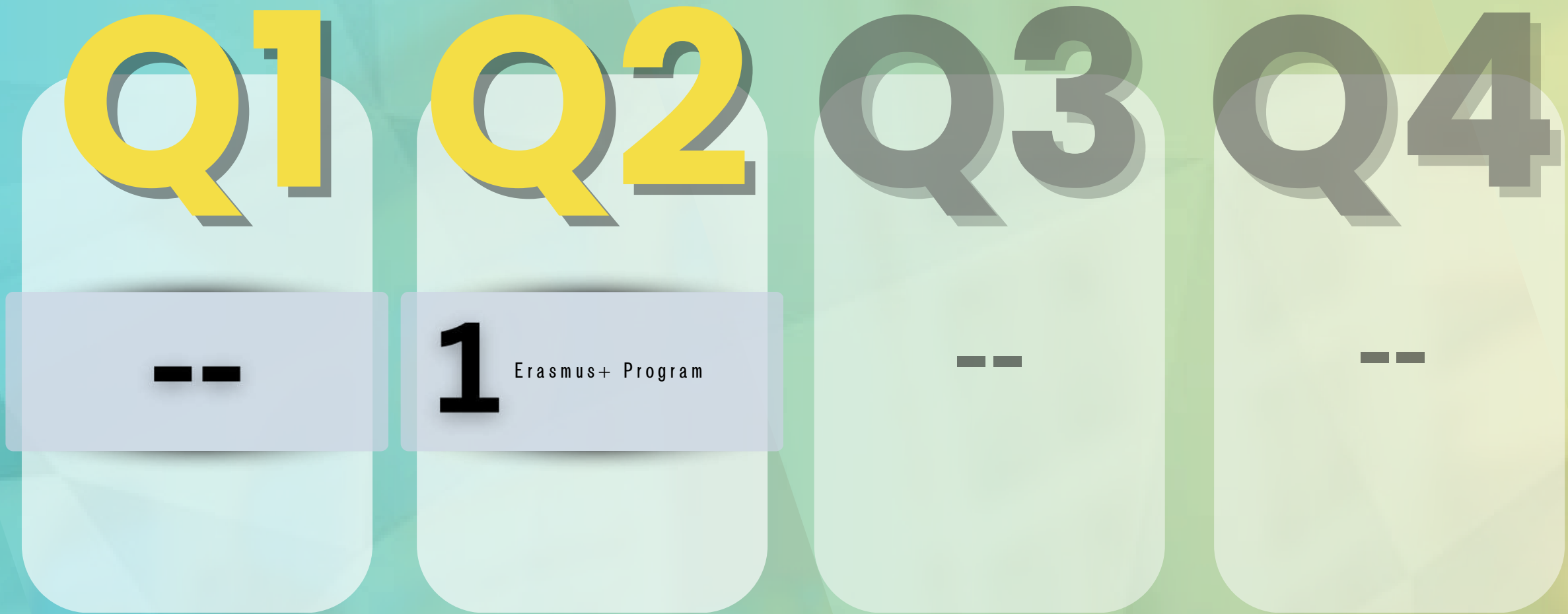

### TSU Joins in Establishing Pathway Pilipinas

Tarlac State University (TSU) formalized its commitment to refugee education by signing a Memorandum of Agreement alongside six other universities at De La Salle Philippines on March 25, 2025.

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Tarlac State University (TSU) formalized its commitment to refugee education by signing a Memorandum of Agreement alongside six other universities to establish Pathway Pilipinas, a non-profit alliance dedicated to providing educational access to refugees and stateless persons. The signing ceremony took place at De La Salle Philippines on March 25, 2025.

**The founding members of Pathway Pilipinas** include Columban College Inc. (CCI), De La Salle Brothers Inc. (DLSBI), De La Salle Araneta University (DLSAU), San Beda University (SBU), Saint Louis University (SLU), University of St. La Salle (USLS), and **TSU—the only state university in the alliance.**

The agreement outlines the commitment of member institutions to work collaboratively in offering scholarship grants and other essential resources that support the academic success of Rohingya refugees and stateless individuals. This initiative is part of the Complementary Pathways Program of the Department of Justice-Refugees and Stateless Persons Protection Unit (DOJ-RSPPU) and the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR).
